

Career Headbands

Grade: 2-5

Resources:

Headbands cards

Lesson Ideas:

Print the cards and cut them out. This lesson could be done as a whole class or with a partner.

Partners: One partner holds their card up to their forehead without looking at the card. They then ask their partner questions about the career such as, “Do I have a uniform?” or “Do I need tools?” When the partners guess, trade. The teacher can keep a pile of extra cards at the front for students to trade in for a new card when finished.

As a Class: One student comes to the front of the class. The teacher holds up a card behind them so they can't see. This time, the class puts their hand up and gives clues to the student at the front and the student at the front guesses the job. Be sure to tell the class to not make the clues too easy, especially at first. Ex. “In this job you help people” or “You need to wear a uniform”.

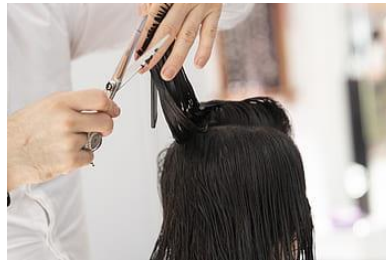

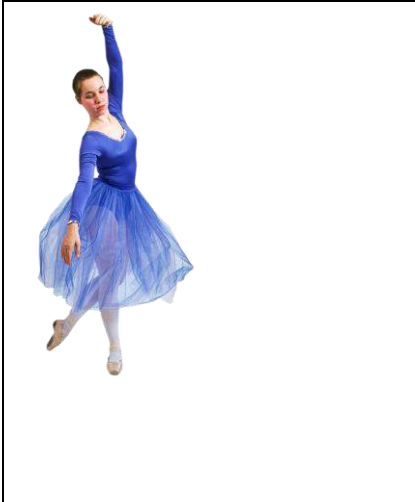
