- <u>6. School Office Summer Schedule</u> The school office will be open regular school hours until Friday, June 28th, closed for Canada Day, Monday, July 1st and then open

Tuesday July 2nd – Thursday 4th from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. The office will then be closed for the summer and will re-open on Monday, August 26th.

- <u>8. Year-End Reports</u> Year-end reports will be handed out to students on the final day of school, Thursday, June 27th. For students finishing the school year earlier, please let your teacher know of your last school day.
- **9. Recycling at School** Students will be asked to bring the contents of their binders, duo-tangs, desks, lockers home and dispose of them there as we simply do not have the capacity to handle the large volume of paper produced for 465 students. Thanks for your understanding.
- <u>10. School Supplies for 2024-2025</u> For primary students (K-3), the same school supply system will be in place as previous years the school/class provides all necessary supplies and materials and parents are asked to pay for their use. The provincial government and SD71 have subsidized school supplies through a student affordability grant. They are providing 20\$ per student, which means parents will be asked to pay the remaining 20\$.

For Intermediate students (gr. 4-7), we'll be changing over to the same system as primary students where the school/class provides all necessary supplies and materials. This approach will ensure equity and equality among all students and will save parents time (no shopping!) and money as our bulk discount is significant. Students will have the materials when needed as everything will be in the classroom. We hope this will help reduce waste, cost, the pressure of last-minute shopping and ensure all students are ready to learn with all their supplies when needed. All materials left over at the end of the school year will remain in classes and reduce what is ordered for the following year. The provincial government and SD71 have subsidized school supplies through a student affordability grant. They are providing 20\$ per student, which means parents will be asked to pay the remaining 20\$.

Payment for school supplies can wait until late August/early September, but if you must do it now, you can e-transfer \$20 to robbroad@sd71.bc.ca. Please be sure to write School Supplies 24-25 and your child's name. As always, parents are still expected to provide a backpack, lunch kit and water bottle. Families requiring financial assistance to pay for school supplies may contact any staff member.

<u>11. First Day of School in September</u> – Students going into grades 1 to 7 return to school on Wednesday, September 4th and will attend from 8:40 am until 11:45 am.
