Application Deadline – March 6th, 2025 by 3:30pm

Basic Information:

Purpose: "....to recognize graduating BC students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. These scholarships are intended to provide tuition assistance to the students pursuing post-secondary education."

There are 5,500 awards distributed across BC school districts and independent school authorities.

Selected students receive a \$1,250.00 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Must also be a BC Resident.
- 2. Student must be enrolled at Highland Secondary School this current school year.
- 3. Student must be in a position to fulfill the BC graduation requirements by August 31st of current graduation year.

<u>Categories</u>: (Students may apply for any category but can receive only ONE scholarship). Please note that involvement in these categories can take place in school and/or in the community.

- Indigenous Languages & Culture
- o Fine Arts Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music
- Applied Design, Skills and Technology Business Ed., Technology Ed., Home Ec., Computers
- Physical Activity not limited to PE courses
- International Languages
- o Community Service volunteer activity
- Technical & Trades Training, Automotive, Robotics, Woodwork, Culinary Arts (apprenticeship programs)
